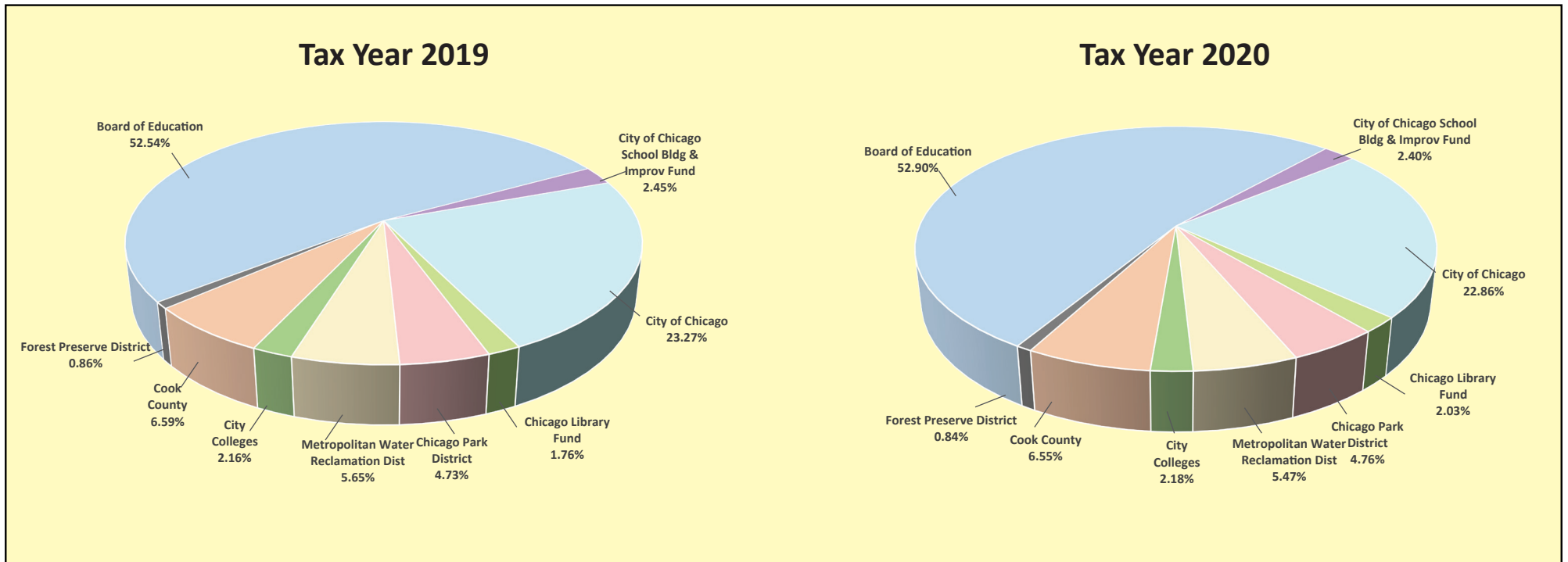


Distribution of Tax Dollars to Taxing Districts in the City of Chicago

Where do taxes go in the City of Chicago?

Once tax revenue is collected, it is distributed to the taxing districts. Below is an illustration of how tax dollars were distributed to taxing districts in the City of Chicago last year (Tax Year 2019) compared to this year (Tax Year 2020) for a typical* Chicago taxpayer. A majority of the typical tax bill goes to the Chicago Board of Education.



**Typical Chicago taxpayers are those who do not pay a portion of their tax bills to special districts which provide services such as mosquito abatement or home equity assurance of other special purposes.*

Distribution of Tax Dollars to Taxing Districts in Suburban Cook County

Where do taxes go in the Suburbs?

Once tax revenue is collected, it is distributed to the taxing districts. Below is an example of how tax dollars may be distributed to taxing districts in one Northern Suburb (the Village of Niles) compared to one Southern Suburb (the Village of Tinley Park) for Tax Year 2020. School districts receive the largest portion of suburban tax bills.
